Moving On On the Beach

In the On the Beach project, your child will learn about animals that live in rock pools and on the seashore. This follows on wonderfully from our trip to Bristol Aquarium. They will find out about and share our experiences of days out at the beach and compare these with beach holidays in the past. They will explore the importance of looking after the environment to keep living things safe. The children will also learn about sun and water safety.

- Encourage your child to talk about their favourite learning experiences from the year and their successes and achievements.
- Talk about change and encourage your child to explain what they are looking forward to when they move into Year 1
