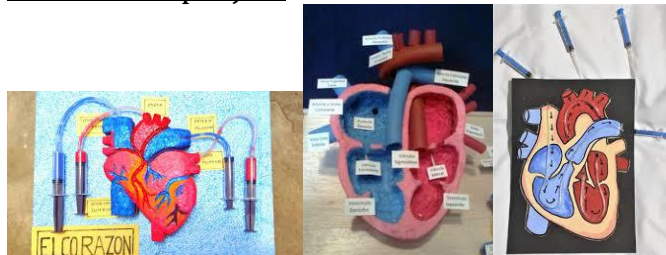
Start and finish times:
